


But how do we do that? How do we put knowledge into action?



1.Complete background check (\$20)

2.Set up face to face meeting time and location.

3. Training practice with PowerPoint presentation

4. Order training t-shirt (\$20)

5. Perform training with a seasoned trainer.

6.Learn other presentations if desired.
