Every generation has a job to do. There is no free ride to freedom. Every individual has a part to play, and each and every one of us has to ask ourselves every day, “Are we doing our part?”

It is *NOT* the Lord’s will that anyone should be hurt in any way, especially by a fellow human.

We can’t stick our heads in the sand and pretend the problem of human trafficking doesn’t exist, or that it won’t effect “our world”, or our own little bubble in this life. It is not a matter of if, but when, the human trafficking industry comes for our children — *no one* is exempt.

Do you run fire drills in your home or your school or your place of employment, just so you are prepared in the event of an emergency? Do you have a protocol in place for when someone is sick or injured? Shouldn’t we be doing more to ensure we are prepared in the event of possible grooming or trafficking happening to our families or people we know — especially in schools where kids can be taught about sex, but not how to protect themselves from being exploited for it? What if you have an addiction, such as porn or drugs — both of which are tied directly with human trafficking — and that addiction is suddenly triggered? What is your protocol? Your first step should be turning to the Lord.

Are we turning to the Lord and repenting daily? We should be. When sin entered the camp of Israel in Numbers chapter 25, a plague was released upon the entire group, all because of the actions of only a portion of the people who were making demonic agreements, thus causing an opening for the enemy to strike the camp internally. The Lord passed judgment on those who were responsible for the problem, and only when such agreements were aggressively put to a stop did the plague end. We believe the plague of human trafficking can and will end. But every individual has to ask whether their actions are part of the reason the plague is still ongoing, or if they are a part of the solution.

It is not enough just to be aware of the problem. We have to know that this is a fight that effects every single one of us, and if we don’t do something about it, the next generation will have to. But at this rate, they will all be enslaved if we don’t put our foot down and say enough is enough! And can we expect them to know what freedom is if we aren’t willing to stand up for it, let alone fight for it?

The Lord EMPOWERED us with the authority to trample on snakes and scorpions (Luke 10:19), and even said in Genesis 11:6 that when the people are united, *nothing* would be impossible for them! So what are we waiting for?? Let’s put on the whole armor of God and *DO* this!!
