**You were made to be a vessel one way or another. The only difference is what you allow yourself to be filled up with.**

If you have ever seen an example of what the human brain looks like on pornography and what it looks like on drugs, you know that it can be hard to tell the difference. Sexual immorality has been in the devil’s strategy to destroy people from the beginning of time. Why? Because he is determined to corrupt the identity and the function of human beings. In Genesis 1:27-28, when the Lord made male and female in His image, He blessed them and told them, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” (ESV)

The Lord gave humans authority over the earth and told them to procreate so they could fill it. The devil has been trying to take authority from the children of God since the beginning of time, starting with Adam and Eve. When they both ate of the forbidden fruit, they completed a transaction that gave the devil legal access to do just that. However, Jesus, who was slain from the foundation of the world (Revelation 13:8 NKJV), redeemed us by the shedding of His own Blood. All who come into agreement with the Blood Covenant of Jesus Christ, or become born again by praying the prayer of salvation and giving their lives to Christ, give the Lord legal access to their lives.

However, while a born again person’s spirit is untouchable by the enemy, their mind, or their soul (which is where their will resides) is a different matter. The reason why Romans 12:2 says to renew our minds is because spiritual warfare actually takes place in our minds. If we allow the devil to influence our thoughts, we can find ourselves siding with him, sometimes whether we realize it or not. The good news is, we can shut him out. We can also repent and turn our focus back to the Lord.

That tug of war feeling inside of you is the difference between your spirit, which is made perfect and is in alignment with the Lord; and your soul, which is being preyed upon by the enemy. There are countless people in the world who have sided with the devil, many of them knowingly, though many unaware. It is not an accident you are faced with an onslaught of temptations day after day, whether it be sugar, caffeine, sex or any other hook the enemy would keep you bound with. The more you fill yourself up by consuming any addiction, the more room you are giving to the enemy inside of yourself. That space is meant for the Holy Spirit, which is why it is important to ask the Holy Spirit to fill you after you receive salvation, so the Lord can bring you inner peace and counsel you on a more intimate level. The more of yourself that you give over to the Lord, the more He can help you. But He isn’t going to forcefully enter where He isn’t permitted.

“Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.” Matthew 26:41 ESV

“But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.” 1 Corinthians 9:27 ESV. This was the apostle Paul speaking. He had to work at keeping himself disciplined because he also, being a believer and follower of Jesus Christ, was not immune to the struggles of being a human in a fallen world. If he hadn’t taken the time to work on himself, think of the generations that could have been lost because of his decisions.

Pornography isn’t harmless. Many people are recorded while they are being exploited and then the material is uploaded to the internet. The more that content is consumed, the more demand it creates. The more demand it creates, the more victims of sexual exploitation there will be. It is a vicious cycle that is of the
