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You have more influence over whether or not the Lord’s will is done in your life than you might think.

You may be wondering, how in the world can someone say a thing like that?

Did you know the Lord is not actually in control of this world? 2 Corinthians 4:4 refers to Satan as the god of this world. This is because of what occurred in the Garden of Eden. When sin first entered the world, it was because the devil was given legal access to it because of the choices that were made by the first humans. However, Jesus, the Lamb, was slain from the foundations of the world (Revelation 13:8). The Lord is not bound by time and space. He made a way for people to be redeemed before He even made them and gave them a free will. When you repent and receive Jesus as your savior, you are literally being transferred from the kingdom of darkness into the Kingdom of Light (Colossians 1:13-14). Even though you don’t physically go anywhere, your spirit does. Ephesians 2:4-6 in the ESV says, “But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,”

Ephesians 1:20-21 tells us where the Lord is seated: Far above every ruler, authority, power, dominion, or any other name that can be named, either in this age or the age to come. The Lord is seated above the devil.

Our spirits are seated in Heavenly realms with the Lord, which is the position that Jesus bought for us with His Blood. He gave us direct communication with our Father, which is why it is so important to accept the Holy Spirit (John 14:16-17, John 20:22, Acts 2:1-4). This is how the Lord speaks to our hearts.

So, if this is the case, what else could there be for us to worry about here on earth? The enemy of your soul is after your relationship with your Heavenly Father.

According to the Word of God, you are made up of three parts: spirit, soul and body (1 Thessalonians 5:23). When you are born again, your spirit is untouchable by the enemy. But your soul isn’t. Your soul is your mind, will and emotions. While our spirit is made new and perfect, our soul is still in a fallen state and is vulnerable to being preyed upon by the enemy. This is why Romans 12:2 reminds us of our personal responsibility to take ownership of renewing our own minds. We must use the Word of God daily as our standard. Hebrews 4:12 in the NKJV says, “For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.” Remember that Jesus is the Word of God (John 1:14), which means He is also the Sword of the Spirit. When the enemy comes to tempt us in our thoughts and emotions in an attempt to get us to side with him on whatever lies he is telling that day, if we are fully submitted to the Lord, then what the devil is going to see when we turn to face him is Jesus, because we have remained in Him and He in us. The enemy knows when you are fully submitted and fully convinced of who your God is. Which is exactly why his tactics involve doubt and deception. The enemy needs your permission, and the way you avoid giving it to him is to continually side with the Lord. Rise up and make the commitment to destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:5). Your will and the decisions you make can either help or hinder the Lord’s will being done in your life, and in turn, others’ lives. Entrusting your soul to the Lord cuts off that avenue through which the enemy will try to influence you.

And no matter what, remember that God is love (1 John 4:8), and love conquers ALL!!

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If you have not received salvation through Jesus Christ and you want to, say the following prayer:

Lord God, I confess that I am a sinner. I confess that I need Your Son, Jesus. Please forgive me in His name. Lord Jesus, I believe You died for me and that You are alive and listening to me now. Now, fill me with Your Holy Spirit, who will show me how to live for You. I acknowledge You before men as my Savior and my Lord.
