God is Restoring Your Boundaries and Your Peace

God is raising you up and restoring your boundaries. He is here to help you every step of the way (Isaiah 41:13). He feels what you feel, when you feel it. But He also sees things from Heaven's perspective, and He wants to line your perception up with His so that You can see what He sees. Let Him walk you through it. Take a moment every day to renew your mind (Romans 12:2), and give yourself some grace, because He is sure willing to do just that (2 Corinthians 12:9). You are loved.

The Lord knows how to love you the way you should be loved.

He isn't going to 'love' you the way people who've hurt you in the past may have. He is going to love you in His perfect way. There is no evil in Him. He is not the cause of wrong doings. He is not trying to 'teach you a lesson'. He is trying to help you heal. It was never His plan for you to go through such hard times. His plan has always been for you to be healed and whole, and for you to have a life full of Godly purpose (Jeremiah 29:11). Tell Him your frustrations, tell Him your desires, your hopes and dreams and fears and hesitations. He wants to hear your voice, and He wants to hear you speaking to Him from a place of honesty, no matter how raw or angry or sad or happy that may be. He wants to counsel you to make different decisions that will lead to you living a better life full of abundance and freedom (John 14:26; John 10:10; 2 Corinthians 3:17).

As you allow the Lord to restore your boundaries, you will find yourself making different decisions than you would have before. You'll find that you value yourself and your dignity and your safety in ways you might never have expected. Others may not understand, or may even get upset at times. But as you practice implementing and enforcing those boundaries, you will also find that you have much more peace in your life than the times when you constantly gave too much of yourself away.

Rest in Him, knowing that His desire is for you to truly have peace. (John 14:27)

If you have not received salvation through Jesus Christ and you want to, say the following prayer:

Lord God, I confess that I am a sinner. I confess that I need Your Son, Jesus. Please forgive me in His name. Lord Jesus, I believe You died for me and that You are alive and listening to me now. I now turn from my sins and welcome You into my heart. Come and take control of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be. Now, fill me with Your Holy Spirit, who will show me how to live for You. I acknowledge You before men as my Savior and my Lord. Thank you for forgiving me, Lord. I receive forgiveness, in Jesus' name, Amen!
