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Freedom Through the Blood of Jesus!

God is the most wonderful, amazing, loving, caring Father in existence. He breathed every one of us into existence by the breath of His Holy Spirit and formed our bodies in our mothers' wombs for our spirits to go into (Psalm 139:13-16; John 1:1-3) We are His children.

While this is all absolutely true, we must also not forget that, because of the events that took place in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:1-7), the devil has legal access to the earth, and is even known as the “god of this world” (2 Corinthians 4:4). However, there is a difference between the god of this world, and the One who is seated far above every ruler, authority, power, dominion or any other name that can be named, either in this age or in the age to come (Ephesians 1:20-23). The thing is, Jesus has already overcome this world! (John 16:33)

This is why Jesus talked about being sent into the world, but not belonging to the world (John 17:14-19). We are to be set apart. What happens when we are not set apart? Bondage.

How do we set ourselves apart and become set free? By accepting the terms of the Blood Covenant of Jesus Christ, the most powerful covenant that has ever existed — and that ever will. No demon can overcome it. (John 1:5)

When Jesus was crucified, He legally took our place in the transaction that fulfilled the requirements for the redemption of our souls (John 3:16; Ephesians 1:7). Jesus bought you back from the devil's domain (Colossians 1:13-14). When you accept that (Romans 10:9-10), you accept freedom. Once you obtain this freedom, it is imperative that you make it a point to remain focused on God every day of your life, because every day there is a battle for your soul. This is true whether you have already accepted Jesus or not, because God is never going to stop fighting for you, no matter how much you give in to temptation and sin (which is the devil's battle strategies) or not.

This is where the battle against human trafficking began, why there is a target on every child, and why we have ALL got to remain informed and aware of the tactics of the enemy and be proactive against the work of the devil. Traffickers get their tactics straight from the devil. Most sex trafficking victims don't self identify as such. This is especially because of the amount of grooming and desensitization that happens to a person leading up to the point of being trafficked. Victims are often manipulated into believing their abuser is the only one that cares about them, all while continuing to be abused.

This is the work of the devil.

We have to stay aware of who we are in Christ — the children of the Most High God! When we discern who we are, and the value our Heavenly Father has placed in us, we recognize when we are being mistreated, and we are empowered to make decisions that ultimately lead to our freedom in Christ Jesus.

Let the Holy Spirit show you the truth (John 16:13). The enemy of your soul isn't capable of overcoming that.

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If you have not received salvation through Jesus Christ and you want to, say the following prayer:

Lord God, I confess that I am a sinner. I confess that I need Your Son, Jesus. Please forgive me in His name. Lord Jesus, I believe You died for me and that You are alive and listening to me now. I now turn from my sins and welcome You into my heart. Come and take control of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be. Now, fill me with Your Holy Spirit, who will show me how to live for You. I acknowledge You before men as my Savior and my Lord.

Thank you for forgiving me, Lord. I receive forgiveness, in Jesus' name, Amen!
