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A Letter to the Children

Though you have been through suffering, He can bring correction and heal those wounds in ways nothing else can. You are never alone, children. For He will be with you.

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We have to stay aware of who we are in Christ — the children of the Most High God! When we discern who we are, and the value our Heavenly Father has placed in us, we recognize when we are being mistreated, and we are empowered to pray for those who persecute us, and to make decisions that ultimately lead to our freedom in Christ Jesus.

If you have not received salvation through Jesus Christ and you want to, say the following prayer:

Lord God, I confess that I am a sinner. I confess that I need Your Son, Jesus. Please forgive me in His name. Lord Jesus, I believe You died for me and that You are alive and listening to me now. I now turn from my sins and welcome You into my heart. Come and take control of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be. Now, fill me with Your Holy Spirit, who will show me how to live for You. I acknowledge You before men as my Savior and my Lord.

Thank you for forgiving me, Lord. I receive forgiveness, in Jesus' name, Amen!
